

Headteacher's Comment:

Dear Parents and Carers,

As we reflect on the recent short week due to the bank holiday, I would like to share the many achievements our children accomplished during this time.

On Tuesday, the children participated in an assembly led by Mrs Creasy, dedicated to the significance of VE Day and its 80th anniversary. This important historical event was further commemorated on Thursday when all the children came together for a picnic on the field, where they enjoyed music from the era. I am pleased to say that the behaviour of our children during this event was exemplary, showcasing the pride we take in their conduct and the values instilled at Hogarth.

Additionally, our Year 4 children had an amazing experience as they travelled to Kent Life to partake in a Viking-themed activity. Feedback from members of the public and staff regarding our children's behaviour and attitudes was overwhelmingly positive.

This week, we were also fortunate enough to welcome the local fire brigade, who delivered an engaging assembly on summer safety, organised by Mrs Connor. It is vital to remember that these assessments are designed to measure academic ability, not the personal growth our children have demonstrated over the past couple of years. I have every confidence they will approach the tests with determination, and I look forward to serving them with breakfast each morning at 8am to help support them during this time.
