Dear parents and carers,

As we reach the end of Week Two, I would like to take a moment to reflect on the exciting progress our children are making. As you may have observed during our Meet the Teacher sessions, the classrooms are truly conducive to learning. Our students are already forming strong and positive relationships with their new class teachers, which is wonderful to see.

You should have received the curriculum letter detailing what the children will be focusing on this term, along with suggestions on how you can support their learning at home. One of the key areas we are emphasising is the importance of reading. We believe it is vital for the children to read at home at least three times a week, with a reading record signed by an adult each time.
