Dear Parents and Carers

As we settle into Week 3 of the term, I am delighted to share that last week our attendance figures reached new heights! For the first time during my tenure at Hogarth, every class achieved attendance above 90%, with an impressive seven out of ten classes boasting over 95%. This is a fantastic achievement and highlights the importance of regular attendance in allowing our children to access the full curriculum and build upon the knowledge gained in previous lessons.

While we're celebrating these positive attendance figures, I must address a concern regarding reading at home. I am proud to report that they behaved impeccably while learning about seasonal food and their senses. Additionally, our Year 6 children began their swimming sessions and thoroughly enjoyed the experience, demonstrating many of the values we expect here at Hogarth.

I would also like to extend my congratulations to the young children who received their leadership and responsibility badges today. It is vital for us to develop leadership among our children, as we believe that their contributions will help Hogarth continue to improve.
