Dear Parents/Carers,

Another enriching week at Hogarth! Along with their curriculum lessons to build knowledge and to challenge them academically, our children have also had lots of opportunities to help them build a love of learning and develop skills for their future.

The week kicked off with Hogarth being the host for the Multi-Schools' Council meeting where children with SEND from other schools joined us to discuss how we should all have mental health awareness. Our children were great ambassadors for Hogarth, displaying responsibility and reflectiveness in their discussions.

Year 5 joined in with a digital 'STEM with Wings' event and had the opportunity to meet two NASA engineers who live on Earth but work on Mars! The engineers are currently developing and testing innovative ways to clear junk from space. Our children heard about other examples through history where engineers have taken inspiration from nature and were challenged to design their own flying vehicle or robot that solves a problem based on something from the natural world.

Year 3 have had a very busy week with food! They spent the morning in Pizza Express in Brentwood High Street, learning about the restaurant's history; what ingredients are used and where they come from and made their own Margherita pizza to take home! Our children displayed respectfulness and impeccable manners to our local community. Then, they were joined by Sandra from the Food Discovery programme to taste different fruits and vegetables, blindfolded!

Thursday was World Mental Health Day and our children downed tools for one hour and focussed on their mental health. They learnt about what mental health is; how it affects the way we feel, think and act; and learnt about ways to keep mentally healthy.

At the end of the week, Don Rae was back for another fantastic dance workshop! The theme this time was Black History Month and the children developed a wealth of skills like team work and performing whilst having lots of fun!

Finally, Coach Tarik is running a fun-filled multi-sports camp during half term. These sessions are being run daily from 4.11.24 to 8.11.24 and cost £30 for a day pass or £120 for a week pass.
